

## SITCPLA OPENS NEW SECTION IN PLUS ULTRA

Today, June 12, **the cabin crew of Plus Ultra airlines have set up a new union section at SITCPLA**, the Independent Cabin Crew Trade Union. From the SITCPLA Board of Directors we would like to congratulate our colleagues on the step they have taken and **welcome them to the largest cabin crew union in Spain**. We also want to thank the Plus Ultra cabin crew for the trust they have placed in our union, which encourages us to continue working to defend the interests of the cabin crew community in our country, as we have been doing for more than thirty years.

The Plus Ultra cabin crew have democratically elected three colleagues as the section chief, his deputy and a member of the section board. The result of the vote has been unanimous, and participation has almost reached 100% of the new affiliates. With these participation figures, **the new section is created with drive and enthusiasm**, aware of the challenges facing the air transport sector, due to the coronavirus pandemic.

In order to face together the challenges posed by the current situation, **Plus Ultra's cabin crew have decided to organize themselves within SITCPLA, the professional union of cabin crew in Spain**. Together, they will have more strength to defend their rights and claims. They will also have the backing of SITCPLA's legal advice, which has extensive experience in the particularities of our profession.

Founded in 1986, **SITCPLA currently has seven union sections in the main airlines** with bases in Spanish territory: Air Europa, easyJet, Finnair, Iberia, Norwegian, Ryanair and SAS Ireland, to which is now added the Plus Ultra section.

Plus Ultra is a Spanish airline, which has four aircraft in its fleet: two Airbus 340-300 and two units of A-340-600. Plus Ultra flies regularly to Quito, Guayaquil, Lima, Caracas, Cartagena de Indias and Cali. In addition, Plus Ultra also operates flights in the wet lease mode.

We want to end by thanking the Plus Ultra cabin crew for their trust in SITCPLA, underlining that they will be able to count on the support of the entire Board of Directors for what they need, and wishing them the best of luck in the journey they are beginning now.
