



SITCPLA SUPPORTS THE STRIKE OF MARCH 8th

On the occasion of the Working Woman's Day, SITCPLA, wants to express its support to the various mobilizations and stoppages called on March 8th by numerous social organizations.

Grouped around the "Comisión 8 de marzo", these social movements have been the origin of the mobilizations that have, subsequently, received the support of Unions and some Political Parties.

Different calls come together: selective strikes of two hours per shift as well as 24 hours strikes, depending on the Unions calling

We understand that the "Ministerio de Fomento" will publish the minimum services for the action day of March 8th which will have to be complied.

In any case, on this vindication day there will be SITCPLA union reps available in the usual telephone numbers, to answer any question you might have.

Concerning the group we represent, fortunately female cabin crew do not suffer the discrimination problems or salary gap that women from other sectors and professional groups suffer of. This does not, however, prevent SITCPLA from supporting the mobilizations and stoppages convened for this March 8th, Working Women's Day, which aims to raise awareness among the population and the authorities of the problems that women continue to cope with in the professional field in addition to continuing to face the burden of domestic tasks, unbalanced compared to that of men, in what is an exhausting double working day.

We reiterate our support for these mobilizations and are at your disposal for any clarification that you might need.
