In SITCPLA we are really concerned about the new direction the company has taken regarding blue-tickets.

The blue-ticket system has been one of the few benefits, not to say the only one that the company has granted us throughout these years.

Suddenly and without any prior notice the whole system has changed in an astonishing and impoverished manner. We are used to unilateral decisions taken for us, but this defies all logic and can only be interpreted as detriment of our conditions. It is necessary that this issue is addressed as soon as possible in order to minimise the negative impact this decision is already having amongst Crew all over the network.

SITCPLA is launching a nation wide campaign to which we welcome all crews and Unions across Europe to adhere to.

All collectives Cabin Crew and Pilots are affected by this unilateral decision that undermines one of the traditional perks of working in the airline business.

Our previous system cannot be compared to those of other airlines who enjoy greater benefits than us, but at least brought a kind of reward to our efforts. All of these has been erased with the new policy.

The confirmed status of the new tickets and a 20 kg checked in bag is not an improvement. The unrealistic policies about its use and booking periods for high season or to be used a normal blue ticket for your children, when with previous system we had 2 extra blue tickets for them.

We encourage all crew to sign our petition and make a formal complaint to the company.
