

Dear colleagues,

Summer 2019 is in our front door and so is disruption.

During the Industrial Relations Conference we assisted on the 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup> of March we heard from easyJet management the measures that are being put into place in order to try to minimize the disruption.

Focusing on ourselves and how this will impact on our Spanish bases we would like to share with you the following;

- Number of SBY aircrafts around the network will be double of what where last year. BCN would be a preferred location in which to base one of these SBY aircrafts however this is still under review and we are uncertain that this will occur.
- There will be an increase of late SBY's rostered and a decrease on early SBY's.
- There will be a noticeable increase of 2 sector duties as a percentage of last year's 4 sector pairings will be split.
- The rerouting of flights to avoid ATC hot spots, such as Marseille, is something that will be more common during this year. Meaning that the duration of the flights might be extended in some occasions in order to prevent long ATC slots.
- It is an **absolute necessity for us to REPORT** all fatigue duties and situations to get anything changed. If a trend is identified by scheduling (3 weeks repetition or more) the airline will review the situation and will try to address it for the next roster.
- Crewing officers are clearly instructed **NOT** to put any pressure to crew in order to take the decision to operate under discretion. If this is not complied, you need to **LET IT KNOW TO ANY OF YOUR UNION REPS**, we are here to support you and report it through the appropriate channels.
- Regarding BREXIT; all cabin crew training, no matter what the final outcome is, will still be carried out in Luton or Gatwick until 2020.  
As well in case of **no deal** Austrian AOC cabin crew will **NOT** be allowed to operate UK AOC and vice versa.
