

Dear colleagues, today we had an ordinary ERTE follow up meeting with the airline, after which we would like to share with you the following:

You all know by this point the situation in Europe, and most specifically in Spain regarding the COVID-19. The latest announcement from some European countries, but mostly the UK, regarding the recommendation of not visiting Spain or imposing quarantines to those who do has an obvious negative impact in the operation.

As a result of it, the airline has decided to act and review its current flying schedule for August and the upcoming months.

Situation stands as follows:

- There is **NO variation** in the number of crew needed for the August schedule although there might be less flights to operate because of the UK Foreign Office announcement.
- September flying schedule is **currently under review** and subject to the evolution of the COVID restrictions around the network.
- We will receive a **further update**, on a yet to be scheduled meeting, around the end of next week or beginning of the other, between **the 8th-15th August** in which we should have more clarity on the predicted flying scheduled for September and beyond.
- Regarding training, whilst we have information that the academy will re-open in August, this will be done in the most restrictive manner, with limited number of “students” per class and with a extremely limited Hotel capacity and food provision. Meaning that the facilities will only be available for strictly necessary training based in the operational needs of the airline, so at this point there is no guarantee on when those of you who have expired Fire training will be able to assist.
- As for SEPE missing payments, we are aware of still few cases. The airline once again has reassured that all the necessary paperwork has been submitted and that financial alternatives have been offered to those of you who are still waiting. Please remember to copy us in your emails to HR regarding these issues.

We will keep you updated with any relevant information that comes up during the upcoming meetings bearing in mind the current scenario is on permanent change.
