CLA UPDATE

Last Monday, the II CLA was signed, which will be in force until 28th February 2025. Once signed, it was sent to the labour authorities and will soon be published in the BOE (Official State Gazette).

In the next payslip you will see the following retroactive payments corresponding to the 2023 salary increase:

- 4% increase in March and April 23 basic salary.
- 13% increase in March and April 23 basic salary
- 17% increase from May 23 basic salary

Together with these increases there will be a readjustment of the retroactive payment received last month covering the 4% salary increase until 28/02/2023 for seasonal bases.

Please find below the table with the increase of the basic salary:
